Dear John:

I am pleased to hear that 273 Senators and Representatives, a bipartisan majority of the Congress, have now joined the Coalition for Peace Through Strength Caucus. This is an important milestone in having the Resolution passed by both Houses of Congress.

I am also encouraged to hear that seven state legislatures have already passed the Resolution.

As an early member of the Coalition for Peace Through Strength, I supported the Resolution, and it was incorporated as part of the 1980 Republican Platform.

Passage of the Resolution by both Houses will be a powerful symbol of bipartisan support for our national security programs, which are designed to restore the margin of safety to our military power.

I assure you that I will sign the Resolution after it is passed by Congress and look forward to hearing of the Coalition's continuing good works.
